LOCATION + HOURS

Rainbow Resource Centre is located on Treaty 1 Territory and the Homeland of the Métis Nation.

These are the traditional territories of the Ininiw (Cree), Anishinaabe (Ojibway), Island Lake Aniciniiw (Oji-Cree), Nakota (Assiniboine), Dakota and Sayisi Dene peoples. We respect the Treaties that were made on these territories, we acknowledge the harms and mistakes of the past, and we dedicate ourselves to move forward in partnership with Indigenous and Two-Spirit communities in a spirit of reconciliation and collaboration.

ACCESSIBILITY

- Ages 14-17 meet on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of the month from 6:00 PM 8:30 PM. Snacks are provided.
- Ages 18-21 meet on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month from 6:00 PM 8:30 PM. Snacks are provided.
- Ages 14-21 Excursion meet off-site on the 4th Saturday of the month from 2:00 PM 5:00 PM. Off-site Saturday excursions may require pre-registration.
- Ages 14-21 BIPOC Space meets from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM on the 4th Saturday of the month. Lunch is provided. Please note that BIPOC Programming is only for youth who self-identify as Black, Indigenous and/or a person of colour.

YOUTH PROGRAM DISCORD SERVER

Youth Program has two **Discord Servers** for ages 14-17 and ages 18-21 so that 2SLGBTQ+ youth across Manitoba can strengthen their peer-networks. Youth can request to join by visiting the Youth Programs page on our website. and clicking the application link.

SOCIAL/SUPPORT GROUPS (18+)

We provide free short-term counselling (up to 8 sessions) and single-sessions to 2SLGBTQ+ and questioning individuals. Our sessions are up to one hour and take place either in-person at Rainbow Resource Centre, through video-call on Zoom, or telephone.
